To enhance the learning experiences of our children through engaging in support activities and facilitating communication between parents, teachers, and school administration.

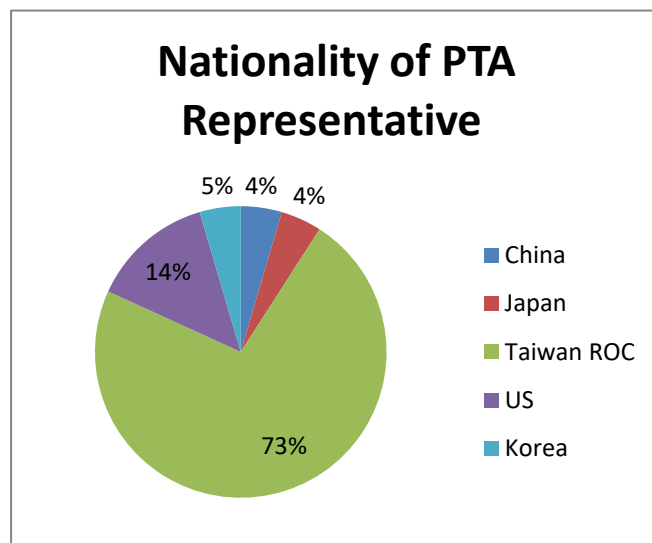
The Purpose:

To support efforts of volunteers in "fundraising" for the benefit of students and the school on a not-for-profit basis.

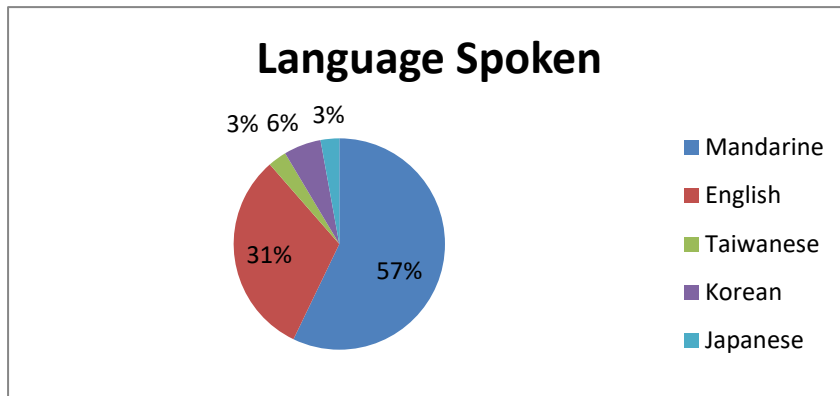

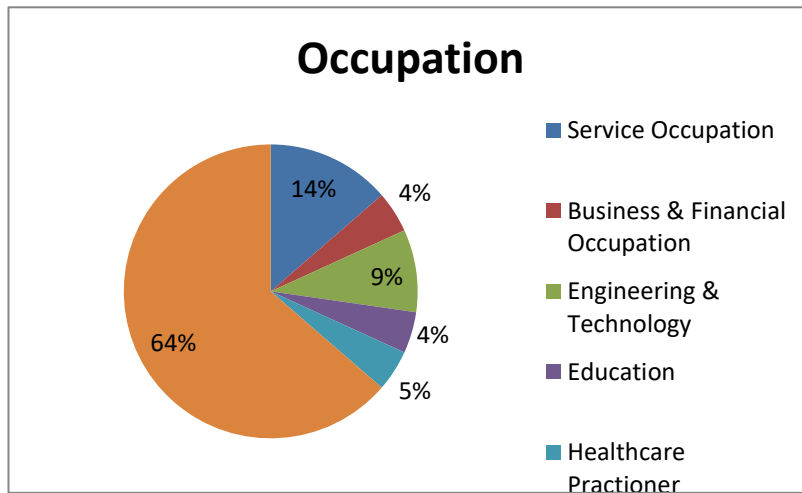

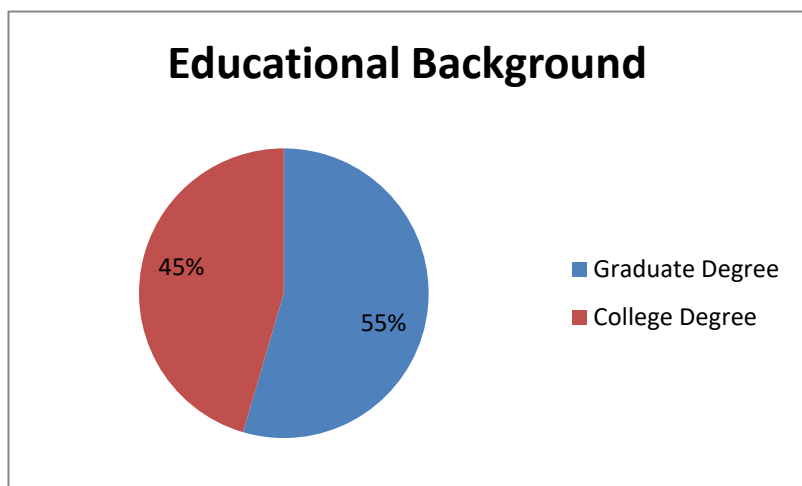

PTA Structure:

PTA ExCo (Executive Committee) members are core members with a group of 5 PTA representatives with different duties. ExCo members include one president, 3 VPs, and one secretary, and our PTA President is elected by ExCo members with one academic year term.

All members of PTA representatives are assigned to one of the three groups, AAO (Academic Affairs Organization), SAO (Student Affairs Organization), and GAO (General Affairs Organization) with an elected group leader and a VP from ExCo overseeing the group functions.
